Sealed tenders IN TWO BID SYSTEM (Technical and Price Bid) are hereby invited for execution of 'Various agricultural/horticultural operations, maintenance of experimental fields, lifting and shifting of plant/ materials, other pot/plant activities and maintenance of distillation units and Generator set' at CSIR-CIMAP RESEARCH CENTRE, BENGALURU from the reputed and experienced firms/agencies/companies established, functioning and registered with Assistant Labour Commissioner as Contractor under the provisions of Contract Labour (Regulation & Abolition) Act, 1970 having at least 5 years experience of rendering similar jobs in Central/ State Govt./ Autonomous Bodies/ Public Undertaking/Institutions/CSIR etc. The tenderers should have successfully completed at least three works amounting to 40% or two works amounting to 50% or at least one work amounting to 80% of the estimated cost or above in single contract during the last five years.

The Estimated cost is Rs. 54,75,370/- (Rupees Fifty Four lakhs Seventy Five thousand Three hundred and Seventy only) per year approximately based on Central Minimum Wages Act w.e.f. 1.4.2016 for employees working in agriculture/horticulture/electrical/house keeping etc. and is inclusive of statutory liabilities. 1. Sealed tenders should be submitted in the Office of SCIENTIST-IN-CHARGE, CSIR-CENTRAL INSTITUTE OF MEDICINAL AND AROMATIC PLANTS, RESEARCH CENTRE, ALLALASANDRA, GKVK POST, BENGALURU-560 065. The sealed envelope should be super scribed "Tender for execution of 'Various agricultural/horticultural operations, maintenance of experimental fields, lifting and shifting of plant/ materials, other pot/plant activities and maintenance of distillation units and Generator set' in the Research and Experimental farm at CSIR-CIMAP RESEARCH CENTRE, Bengaluru" due date of opening on 28.7.2016 on the top, which shall contain two envelopes, one technical bid and one price bid.

Tender should be submitted in double cover as mentioned below:

## Envelope "A" (Technical Bid) should contain the following:-

- (i) Particulars of the Tenderer duly filled in the Form-II (attached to this Tender).
- (ii) Experience Certificate along with satisfactory work completion certificate of rendering similar jobs at least three works amounting to 40% or two works amounting to 50% or at least one work amounting to 80% of the estimated cost or above in single contract during the last five years in CSIR/Central/State Govts./autonomous bodies/Public Sector Undertaking, Institutions as provided in Form-III.
- (iii) Copies of Experience Certificate(s) along with satisfactory work completion certificate of having 5 years experience of rendering similar jobs in CSIR/ Central/State Govts./Autonomous Bodies /Public Sector Undertaking, Institutions.

- 2. The Director, CSIR-CIMAP reserves the right to scrutinize credentials of all tenders, and to arrive at a conclusion to its satisfaction regarding the suitability of the party based on such examination/enquiry as deemed necessary. Issuing of tender form will not as such be accepted as proof of eligibility for the contract. A committee will first open envelope `A' in respect of Tenderers and after the committee has satisfied itself that all documents/information required have been furnished and the Tenderer is found suitable and competent for performing the job, committee will open the envelope `B'. In case the Tenderer withholds information/documents or the party is not found suitable, envelope `B' shall not be opened and the Tender will be rejected out rightly.
- 3. Attested copies of performance/experience certificates given by organizations/ undertakings that the contractor has undertaken similar works during last five years must be attached. The certificate should be signed by the Head of Administration where he has provided services. If the signatures are not legible his name may be indicated along with telephone nos. The original certificate should be produced before award of the contract.
- 4. For partnership firms, a copy of the partnership deed may be furnished.
- 5. In case of Co-operative Society a copy of each of Article of Association and the latest certificate from the Registrar, Co-operative Societies mentioning that the Co-operative societies functioning satisfactorily for the last two years as per latest Audit Reports and other relevant record of the society.
- 6. The contractor shall furnish the indemnity bond from the General Insurance company at his own cost to indemnify CSIR-CIMAP/CSIR against any claim arising out of or connected with the Tender.
- 7. Copy of the Income Tax Clearance Certificate of the preceding year in the prescribed proforma issued in the name of the firm/Co-operative society should be enclosed with the Tender.
- 8. Cost of Tender Document (In case of download) and Earnest money in the form of D.D./ Bankers Cheque drawn on a Nationalized Bank in favour of Director, CIMAP, Lucknow should be attached with the Tender in envelope 'A'. Tender without these will not be considered.

- 9. A Valid Character Certificate issued by District Magistrate of the District to be submitted to the effect that the Tenderer or in case of partnership, any of the partners and in case of Co-operative society, the chairman or the secretary of the Co-operative society, whose name find place in the registration documents of the Co-operative society have no criminal record **or** Tenderer has to submit a valid Character Certificate in the form of an Affidavit on the stamp paper of Rs.100/- to the effect that the contractor/firm has not been blacklisted by any Govt. deptt/CSIR as also that there is no criminal case pending against the firm/contractor in any court of Law.
- 10. The contractor has to supply highly skilled/skilled/semi-skilled/unskilled workers, if required for specific technical/experimental works. The wages for the same will be reimbursed to the Contractor on actual basis with service charge approved.
- 11. Monthly payment to the contractor will be released only after production of:
  - a. Self attested Photocopies of the EPF and ESI challan of previous month with workers details and EPF/ESI Code.
  - b. Copy of pay roll with the certificate that all labourers have been paid according to Minimum Wages Act in presence of CSIR-CIMAP's Representative.
- 12. The contractor must be registered under the Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act 1970 as amended. Any obligations and/or formalities which for the purpose of entering into, and/or execution of the contract shall be carried out by the Contractor at his own expenses, etc. and the contractor shall report the compliance thereof to the CSIR-CIMAP (CSIR). The contractor shall be solely liable for any violation of provisions of the said Act or any other Act.
- 13. The contractor may require to engage daily an effective strength of labourers for carrying out the work in the supply of manpower for R&D support activities as required to maintain the quality of works listed in Annexure I. An average manpower of 30 unskilled, 4 skilled, 5 highly skilled, 4 highly skilled (Technical) and 2 for sweeping and cleaning, per day for **26 or 27 days per month** would be required for carrying out the quality work.
- 14. The contractor shall engage only physically fit labourers for the work at his sole and own risk.
- 15. The contractor will have to execute an agreement after the award of the work but before the commencement of the work.
- 16. The contractor shall produce a license/permission from the Labour Commissioner within 15 days of the start of work from Ministry of Labour, Govt. of India for undertaking the work. If the license/permission is not received by the stipulated time, the award of work to him shall be liable to be cancelled and security money will be forfeited.
- 17. Tools and implements and machines required for carrying out different work will be provided by the institute except the small ones to be provided by the Contractor like- Mamti, spade, varari, sickles, bill hooks, guddali, Trea/Hedge Prunners etc.
- 18. Tender submitted shall remain valid for 90 days from the date of the opening for purpose of acceptance and award of work, validity beyond 90 days from the date of opening shall be by mutual consent.

- 19. Labourers may be deputed to do some official work outside the institute like flower show/shifting of materials, if required.
- 20. Contractor or his representative should be present daily at all the sites for supervision.
- 21. Contractor will be wholly responsible for any loss or damage to the property of CSIR-CIMAP done by him or his employees and loss, if any will be deducted from contractor's dues & security money.
- 22. The criteria of evaluation of lowest bidder will be service charge (in percentage) as quoted by the tenderer.
- 23. The contractor has to submit a undertaking along with technical bid that he has cleared all statutory liabilities viz EPF, ESI etc of the all previous labour contract with any Govt./ Semi Govt./ CSIR Institutions.
- 24. Earnest money of Rs. 1,36,885/- in the form of D.D / Bankers Cheque drawn on a Nationalized Bank/commercial bank in favour of Director, CIMAP, Lucknow, payable at Lucknow should be attached with the Tender. Tender without earnest money will not be entertained. The Tender money in any other form will not be accepted.
- 25. The bidding contractor has to submit a written undertaking along with Technical Bid that he has cleared all the statutory liabilities viz. EPF, ESI, minimum wages etc. of the labour contract while he/his firm was dealing with any Govt./csemi Govt./CSIR Institution for last three years.
- 26. The contractor shall comply with all the provisions of Contract labour laws including Employees State Insurance Act and shall keep CSIR-CIMAP absolved from all acts and omissions, faults, breaches and/or claims, demands, loss, injury and expenses to which CSIR-CIMAP may be put or involved as a result the contractor failure to fulfill any of the above obligations and CSIR-CIMAP shall be entitled to recover any such losses and expenses which may have to suffer on account of such claims, demands, loss or injury from the contractors monthly bill or from security deposit or from any money due to contractor without prejudice to its any other rights under the law.
- 27. The contractor shall ensure that all the workers shall get minimum wages and other benefits as admissible under various Labour Laws. The contractor shall provide full information in respect of the wages, etc. paid to its employees so deployed in conformity with the provisions of Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act 1970.
- 28. The manpower engaged by the contractor shall remain under the control and supervision of the contractor and the contractor shall be liable for payment of their wages, etc. and all other dues as applicable and amended from time to time which the contractor is liable to pay under the Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act 1970 and other statutory provisions.
- 29. The Contractor will make payment to the labourers before 10th of each month in presence of committee nominated by Director, CSIR-CIMAP and the date of disbursement of wages has to be displayed well in advance on the notice board of contractor.

- 30. Contractor has to submit copy of payment slip showing name of the labour, no. of attendance, EPF/ESI No., wages per day and all deductions like EPF/ESI etc. along with monthly bill duly certified by CSIR-CIMAP representatives and copy of EPF & ESI Challan with proper proof that the money deducted towards EPF/ESI have been deposited for previous month; CSIR-CIMAP will ensure to make payment to the contractor at the earliest. If the wages are not paid by the Contractor on time, the office shall have the right to deduct the amount from the dues of the Contractor and pay the wages itself. This obligation is imposed on the Contractor to ensure that the Contractor is fulfilling his commitment towards his workers so deployed under various labour laws, having regard to the duties of CSIR-CIMAP (CSIR) in this respect as per the provisions of Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act. 1970. The Contractor shall comply with or cause to be complied with, the contractors labour regulations made by CSIR from time to time in regard to payment of wages, wage period, deduction from wages, recovery of wages not paid and deduction unauthorizedly made, maintenance of wage book, wage slip, publications of scale of wages and terms of employment, inspection and submission of periodical returns.
- 31. Monthly/Six monthly/Yearly statements from EPF & ESI office showing details of amount credited in the account of each labour has to be displayed on the notice board and also copy of same to be submitted in CSIR-CIMAP office.
- 32. In case any of the worker (s) so deployed by the Contractor does not come up to the mark or does not perform his duties properly or any report is received by the contractor about the said person's negligence or non-performance of duty or any unlawful activities or joining in union/association activities of disorderly conduct, the contractor shall, take suitable action against such workers on the report of the authorized Representative of CSIR-CIMAP. The Contractor shall immediately replace that particular person so deployed.
- 33. The Contractor must remove all workers deployed by him on termination of the contract or any ground whatsoever from the premises of the CSIR-CIMAP and ensure that no person shall create any disruption/hindrance/problem of any nature to CSIR-CIMAP (CSIR).
- 34. Workers provided by the Contractor for executing the work contracted out shall be employees of the Contractor and will be on his pay roll and shall receive instructions from him for the work to be carried out by them and for effective discharge of the work. The work will be supervised by the Representative of CSIR-CIMAP and the contract workers shall abide by his instructions.
- 35. The contractor shall provide identity cards to the workers employed by him bearing their photographs, name of the worker, father's name, date of birth and residential address etc. which shall be produced by the worker on demand of any officer or staff of CSIR-CIMAP authorized for this purpose. Further, all the above shall also be submitted to the office.
- 36. The security money will be refunded to the Contractor after the satisfactory performance of the contractor and expiry of the contract period, and submission of Form 3A, Form 6A and Form 23 ensuring that EPF, ESI etc. have been deposited by the contractor.
- 37. The last month payment of the contract will be paid only after receiving the satisfactory completion certificate.

- 38. The contractor shall have to maintain at his own expense attendance register throughout the contract period in which the daily attendance of the workers shall be recorded.
- 39. The Contractor or his authorized representative shall have to be present on the site of work and will be responsible for execution of contract.
- 40. Any alteration/modification in tender documents and giving/submitting wrong/forged information/document will be liable for legal action and the earnest money will be forfeited.
- 41. The Contractor shall be responsible for any loss or damage caused by him or any of his workers by theft or otherwise to the property of the CSIR-CIMAP and shall pay to CSIR-CIMAP on demand at the current value of such properties.
- 43. The Security money so deposited will be liable to be forfeited or appropriated in the event of unsatisfactory performance of the contract and loss or damage, if any, sustained by the institute on account of failure or negligence on the part of employees of contractor.
- 44. The Contractor must be registered under the Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act 1970 as amended. Any obligations and/or formalities which for the purpose of entering into, and/or execution of the contract shall be carried out by the Contractor at his own expenses, etc. and the contractor shall report the compliance thereof to the CSIR-CIMAP (CSIR). The contractor shall be solely liable for any violation of provisions of the said Act or any other Act. The contractor shall furnish an attested copy of Registration Certificate that he is registered under the provision of contract labour (Regulation & Abolition) Act.1970.

- 46. In connection with the services to be provided, the contractor will deploy all the labourers for work between the age of minimum 18 years and maximum 50 years.

## Annexure-I

Experimental fields are spread over an area of about 15 hectares (**38 acres**) linked with roads covering an area of about 2.5 hectares. The various crops of medicinal and aromatic plants are grown in field plots to carry out research experiments involving different field operations (list given below) as per requirement of the crops/plants and field experiments.

Sealed tenders are required to carry out experimental field operations for cultivation and maintenance of medicinal and aromatic plants mentioned below as per the need of the plants and experimental procedure. All the field plots, roads, bunds and farm building surroundings have to be maintained in good condition as per our requirement in consultation with Scientist-in-charge/Farm Manager.

The various medicinal and aromatic plants include perennial crops like aromatic grasses, khus, tree species like *Eucalyptus citriodora*, Bursera and endangered species etc. annual vegetatively propagated crops like patchouli, geranium, rosemary etc. and annual seed propagated crops like Tulsi, Catharanthus, Kalmegh etc. Root and tuber crops like Ashwagandha etc. and agro forestry experiments and processing of aromatic plants.

AGREEMENT FOR THE JOB CONTRACT FOR EXECUTION OF 'VARIOUS AGRICULTURAL/HORTICULTURAL OPERATIONS, MAINTENANCE OF EXPERIMENTAL FIELDS, LIFTING AND SHIFTING OF PLANT/ MATERIALS, OTHER POT/PLANT ACTIVITIES AND MAINTENANCE OF DISTILLATION UNITS AND GENERATOR SET' IN THE RESEARCH AND EXPERIMENTAL FARM AT CSIR-CIMAP RESEARCH CENTRE, BENGALURU

This AGREEMENT made on this ....... day of ....... between the COUNCIL OF SCIENTIFIC & INDUTRIAL RESEARCH, a society registered under the Societies Registration Act and having its office at "Anusandhan Bhawan", Rafi Marg, New Delhi (hereinafter referred to as CSIR) which expression shall unless repugnant to the context or meaning there of be deemed to mean and include its successors and assign of the ONE PART.

#### **AND**

WHEREAS the CSIR is desirous of giving a job contract for carrying out 'Various agricultural/horticultural operations, maintenance of experimental fields, lifting and shifting of plant/ materials, other pot/plant activities and maintenance of distillation units and Generator set' in the Research & Experimental Farm at CSIR-Central Institute of Medicinal and Aromatic Plants, Research Centre, Bengaluru which is a constituent unit of CSIR (hereinafter referred to as Lab/Instt) and whereas the contractor has offered to provide the manpower on the terms and conditions hereinafter stated.

WHEREAS Contractor has represented that he is a registered Contractor under the provisions of Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition Act), 1970 and has further represented that he is eligible to get this contract and there is no legal and any other bar for him in this respect. Any obligation and/ or formalities which are required to be fulfilled under the said Act or any amendment thereto for the purpose of entering into and/ or execution of this contract shall be carried out by the contractor at his own expenses etc. and the Contractor shall report the compliance thereof to the CSIR. The contractor shall be solely liable for any violation of the provisions of the said Act or any other Act.

WHEREAS CSIR has agreed to award the contract of work of execution of 'Various agricultural/horticultural operations, maintenance of experimental fields, lifting and shifting of plant/ materials, other pot/plant activities and maintenance of distillation units and Generator set' in the research and experimental farm at CSIR-CIMAP Research Centre, Bengaluru, hereinafter mentioned as work assigned details of which are given at Annexure I.

AND WHEREAS the Contractor has agreed to furnish to the Lab/Instt. a security deposit of Rs. ...... by way of Fixed Deposit Receipt/D.D. in the name of Director, CIMAP, Lucknow of any Nationalized Bank. Lucknow.

NOW THEREFORE BY THESE ARTICLES AND ON THE PREMISES mentioned above, the parties have agreed to as under:

#### A. GENERAL CONDITIONS

- 1. That it is expressly understood and agreed between the parties to this Agreement that the persons deployed by the Contractor for the services mentioned above shall be the employees of the Contractor for all intents and purposes and that the persons so deployed shall remain under the control and supervision of the Contractor and in no case, shall a relationship of employer and employee between the said persons and the CSIR shall accrue/arise implicitly or explicitly.
- 2. That on taking over the responsibility of the work assigned the Contractor shall formulate the mechanism and duty assignment of work to its personnel in consultation with Director of the Lab./Instt. or his nominee. Subsequently, the Contractor shall review the work assigned from time to time and advise the Director of the Institute, for further streamlining their system. The Contractor shall further be bound by and carry out the directions/instructions given to him by the Director of the Lab./Instt. or the officer designated by the Director in this respect from time to time.
- 3. That the Director of the Lab./Instt. or any other person authorized by the Director shall be at liberty to carry out surprise check on the persons as deployed by the Contractor in order to ensure that persons deployed by him are doing their duties.
- 4. That in case any of the persons so deployed by the Contractor does not come up to the mark or does not perform his duties properly or indulges in any unlawful riots or disorderly conduct, the contractor shall immediately withdraw and take suitable action against such persons on the report of the Lab./Instt/CSIR in this respect. Further, the Contractor shall immediately replace the particular persons so deployed on the demand of the Director of the Lab./Instt/CSIR in case of any of the aforesaid acts on the part of the said person.

#### **B. CONTRACTOR'S OBLIGATIONS**

- 1. That the Contractor shall carefully and diligently perform the work assigned to him as mentioned at Annexure I as deemed fit by him in consultation with the Lab.
- 2. That for performing the assigned work, the contractor shall deploy medically and physically fit persons. The Contractor shall ensure that the persons are punctual and disciplined and remain vigilant in performance of their duty.
- 3. That the Contractor shall submit details of the names, parentage, residential address, age, etc. of the persons deployed by him in the premises of the Lab./Instt/CSIR. For the purpose of proper identification of the employees of the Contractor deployed at various points, he shall issue identity cards bearing their photographs/ identification, etc. and such employees shall display their identity cards at the time of duty.
- 4. The contractor shall remove all workers deployed by him on termination of the contract or on expiry of the contract from the premises of CSIR-CIMAP, Research Centre Bengaluru and ensure

that no such person shall create any disruption/hindrance/problem of any nature in CSIR-CIMAP, Research Centre Bengaluru either explicitly or implicitly.

- 5. That the Contractor shall at his own cost, if required, take necessary insurance cover in respect of the aforesaid services rendered to CSIR and shall comply with the statutory provisions of Contract Labour (Regulation & Abolition) Act, 1970, Employees State Insurance Act, Workman's Compensation Act, 1923, Payment of Wages Act, 1936, The Employees Provident Fund (and Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, 1952, Payment of Bonus Act, 1965, The Minimum Wages Act, 1948 Employer's Liability Act, 1938 Employment of Children Act, 1938, Maternity Act and / or any other Rules/regulations and/or statutes that may be applicable to them and shall further keep the CSIR indemnified from all acts of omission, fault, breaches and/or any claim, demand, loss, injury and expense arising out from the non-compliance of the aforesaid statutory provisions. Contractor's failure to fulfill any of the obligations hereunder and/or under the said Act, rules/regulations and/ or any bye laws or rules framed under or any of these, the CSIR shall be entitled to recover any of the such losses or expenses, which it may have to suffer or incur on account of such claims, demand, loss or injury, from the Contractor's monthly payment.
- 6. That the Contractor shall submit the proof of having deposited the amount of contribution claimed by him on account of ESI & EPF towards the persons deployed at CSIR Lab./Instt. building in their respective names before submitting the bill for the subsequent month. In case the Contractor fails to do so, the amount towards ESI & EPF contribution will be withheld till submission of required documents.
- 7. That the contractor shall particularly abide by the provisions of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 with rules 1950 framed there-under, as amended from time to time. The contractor shall pay monthly wages to his workers at the rate of minimum wages fixed by the Central Government or State Government whichever is higher.
- 8. That the Contractor shall be required to maintain permanent attendance register/roll within the building premises which shall be open for inspection and checking by the authorized officer of CSIR/Lab./Instt.
- 9. That the Contractor shall make the payment of wages, etc, to the persons so deployed in the presence of representative of the Lab./Instt/CSIR and shall on demand furnish copies of wage register/muster roll etc. to the Lab/Instt. for having paid all the dues to the persons deployed by him for the work under the Agreement. This obligation is imposed on the Contractor to ensure that he is fulfilling his commitments, towards his employees so deployed under various Labour Laws, having regard to the duties of CSIR in this respect as per the provisions of Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act, 1970. The Contractor shall comply with or cause to be complied with the Labour Regulations from time to time in regard to payment of wages, wage period, deductions from wages, recovery of wages not paid and deductions unauthorizedly made, maintenance of wages book, wage slip, publication of scale of wage, and terms of employment, inspection and submission of periodical returns.

- 10. The contractor shall take all reasonable precautions to prevent unlawful riots or disorderly conduct or act of his employees so deployed and ensure preservation of peace and protection of persons and property of CSIR.
- 11. That the Contractor shall deploy his persons in such a way that they get weekly rest. The working hours/leave for which the work is taken from them do not violate relevant provisions of Shops and Establishment Act. The Contractor shall in all dealings with the persons in his employment have due regard to all recognized festivals, days of rest and religious or other customs. In the event of the Contractor committing a default or breach of any of the provisions of the Labour Laws including the provisions of Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act, 1970 as amended from time to time or in furnishing any information, or submitting or filling any statement under the provisions of the said regulations and rules which is materially incorrect, they shall without prejudice to any other liability pay to the Director of the Lab./Instt. a sum as may be claimed by Lab./Instt./CSIR.

#### C. CSIR'S OBLIGATIONS

- 1. That in consideration of the services rendered by the contractor as stated above, he shall be paid actual wages plus service charges of the manpower on monthly basis. Such payment shall be made by the 10th day of the month on the basis of the bills raised by the Contractor and duly certified by the officer designated by Lab./Instt. in this regard.
- 2. That the aforesaid payment has been agreed to be paid by CSIR to the Contractor.
- 3. That payment on account of enhancement/escalation charges on account of revision in wages by the appropriate Govt. from time to time shall be payable by the CSIR to the Contractor.
- 4. That the CSIR/Lab./Instt/ shall reimburse the amount of service tax, if any, paid by the Contractor to the authorities on account of the services rendered by him. This reimbursement shall be admissible on production of proof of deposit of the same by the Contractor.
- 5. The security deposit will be refunded to the Contractor within one month of the expiry of the contract only on the satisfactory performance of the contract.

#### D. INDEMNIFICATION

1. That the contractor shall keep the CSIR indemnified against all claims whatsoever in respect of the employees deployed by the contractor. In case any employee of the contractor so deployed enters in dispute of any nature whatsoever, it will be the primary responsibility of the contractor to contest the same. In case the CSIR is made party and is supposed to contest the case, the CSIR will be reimbursed for the actual expenses incurred towards counsel fee and other expenses which shall be paid in advance by the contractor to CSIR on demand. Further, the contractor will ensure that no financial or any other liability comes on CSIR in this respect of any nature whatsoever and shall keep CSIR indemnified in this respect.

2. The contractor shall further keep the CSIR indemnified against any loss to the CSIR property and assets. The CSIR shall have further right to adjust and /or deduct any of the amounts as aforesaid from the payments due to the contractor under this contract.

#### E. PENALTIES/LIABILITIES

- 1. That the Contractor shall be responsible for faithful compliance of the terms and conditions of this agreement. In the event of any breach of the agreement, the same may be terminated and the security deposit will be forfeited and further the work may be got done from another agency at their risk and cost.
- 2. That if the Contractor violates any of the terms and conditions of this agreement or commits any fault or his services are not to the entire satisfaction of officer authorized by the Director of the Lab in this behalf, a penalty leading to a deduction up to a maximum of 10% of the total amount of bill for a particular month will be imposed.
- 3. The security money so deposited shall be liable to be forfeited or appropriated in the event of unsatisfactory performance of the Contractor and/or loss/damage if any, sustained by the Institute on account of the failure or negligence of the workers deployed by him or in the event of breach of the agreement by the Contractor.

#### F. COMMENCEMENT AND TERMINATION

- 2. That this agreement may be terminated on any of the following contingencies:
  - a. On the expiry of the contract period as stated above.
  - b. By giving one month's notice by CSIR on account of:
    - I. For committing breach by the Contractor of any of the terms and conditions of this agreement.
    - II. On assigning the contract or any part thereof to any sub contractor by the Contractor without written permission of the Lab./Instt.
  - c. On Contractor being declared insolvent by competent Court of Law.

During the notice period for termination of the contract in the situation contemplated above, the Contractor shall keep on discharging his duties as before till the expiry of notice period.

It shall be the duty of the contractor to remove all the persons, deployed by him, on termination of the contract, on any ground whatsoever and ensure that no person creates any disruption /hindrance /problem of any nature for Lab./Instt./CSIR.

#### G. ARBITRATION

- 1. In the event of any question, dispute/difference arising under the agreement or in connection herewith (except as to matters the decision of which is specially provided under this agreement) the same shall be referred to the sole arbitration to DGCSIR or his nominee.
- 2. The award of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on the parties. In the event of such arbitrator to whom the matter is originally referred is being transferred or vacating his office or resigning or refusing to work or neglecting his work or being unable to act for any reason whatsoever, the Director-General, CSIR shall appoint another person to act as arbitrator in place of the out-going arbitrator in accordance with the terms of this agreement and the person so appointed shall be entitled to proceed with the reference from the stage at which it was left by his predecessor.
- 3. The expression Director General, CSIR shall mean and include an acting/officiating Director-General.
- 4. The Arbitrator may give interim award (s) and/or directions, as may be required.
- 5. Subject to the aforesaid provisions, the Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996 and the rules made hereunder and any modification thereof from time to time being in force shall be deemed to apply to the arbitration proceedings under this clause.
